

## What is a WWFF area?

WWFF areas include National Parks, Areas of Outstanding Natural Beauty, Natura 2000 areas, areas with RAMSAR Designation, National Nature Reserves, Sites of Special Scientific Importance, Other International and UK Designations such as Local Nature Reserves and Country Parks.

So what are you waiting for? Get out there into the great wide open and get some fresh air. More than 20,000 nature parks worldwide are already registered in the **WWFF Directory**.

The map shows some of the ones local to Telford and you may not have heard of the one closest to Telford - Aqualate Mere NNR which is situated 3 kilometers to the east of Newport, at the heart of a private estate, centered on Aqualate Mere - the largest natural lake in the West Midlands.
